- treat and store materials and products appropriately;
- prepare finished products for shipping.

The graduate is employed in the field of woodworking production, especially in the carpentry and upholstery production, in simple work activities in the production and repairs of carpentry products including construction or in the production and repair of upholstered furniture, in the upholstery of the means of transport or when carrying out simple decoration work. Examples of possible jobs: laborer in carpentry, furniture, upholstery manufacture or in the field of construction carpentry.
